

## **Automotive Services Technology Instructor**

**Job:** Teach high school juniors and seniors Indiana's Career and Technical Education Automotive Services curriculum in Area 30's Automotive shop and classroom. Curriculum includes Principles of Automotive Services, Brake Systems, Steering and Suspension, Engine Performance and Automotive Electrical Systems. Use computer software to support classroom curriculum and school reporting requirements. Create and supervise daily lessons in accordance with the curriculum. Prepare students for S/P2 and ASE certification tests. Maintain relationships and network with local Automotive Service industry professionals for student internship opportunities and for building an advisory board for the career path.
